Another big sale on Friday with a total of **990 head** on offer, mostly heifers this time. **Martin & Linda Dykens** had a set of 20 heifers weighing 720 lbs. and bringing 168.75 their 638 lb. heifers notched 178.75. **HRH Ventures, Ken & Vicky Hill** saw 12 of their 675 lb. heifers reach 173.50 while their 11 head of 586 lb. heifers fetched 189.75. **Andy Meints** with 10 Red heifers at 705 lbs. valued at 179.25. On the lighter side **John Bree** had 29 heifers at 499 lb. climbing to 197.00 with 15 heifers 416 lb. at 203.00 and 9 heifers at 360 lb. maxed out at 207.50. **Eric Newmeister** came with 125 heifers at 627 lbs. they brought 175.50, his 686 lb. heifers peeked at 176.25. **Mountain View Ranch, Darrel and Roseanne Ophus** had a dozen 748 lb. heifers reaching 161.00 and 15 heifers weighing 616 lbs. trading at 180.00. **Ed Klassen** had 10 heifers avg 449 lbs. bringing 190.93. **Down Under Ranch, Darlene McLeod and family** saw their 643 lb. heifers top out at 182.75 and their 689 lb. steers at 189.00. Also with steers was **Pooles Arrow Ranch, Charles and Lynn Poole** at 667 lbs. they fetched 192.25, their 732 lb. steers brought 185.00 and the 572 lb. steers traded at 209.50. **Walter & Susan Steidle** had 703 lb. steers hit 189.00 and their bigger 835 lb. steers at 164.25. 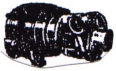
