The 2016 interim applications are available on the AgriStability website. If you would like to apply please go to www.gov.bc.ca/agribusinessmanagement or call our toll free line.

What is an Interim Payment?

An interim payment is an advance on a producer's final 2016 AgriStability benefit. If you have suffered an income decline beyond your control, the interim payment program may be of assistance. The interim benefit is usually up to 50 percent of your estimated final benefit.

Deadline

March 21, 2017

To Qualify

To apply for an interim payment, you must be a participant in AgriStability for the 2016 program year. Application details are available in the Interim Guide. If you receive an interim payment, you must submit a final 2016 Harmonized form by December 31, 2017 so your final AgriStability benefit can be calculated. If you do not submit a complete 2016 application by the deadline date, any interim payment you may receive will be considered to be an overpayment and you will be required to repay any benefits you receive.

Turnaround Time

Turnaround time is 30 days for an interim application
