## Online Direct Equipment Sale Guidelines

- 1) All equipment will be listed on our website [www.bclivestock.bc.ca/equipment-auctions](http://www.bclivestock.bc.ca/equipment-auctions). Like any of our regular equipment sales the information is to the best of our knowledge. As Is, Where Is!! BC Livestock does not guarantee items.
- 2) If you wish to view a listing in person and/or need more information, please contact the representative at the top of the page. We have been hired on behalf of the customer to facilitate the sale of these items, so **please do not contact the seller directly**. Items will be available for viewing at different locations so please contact the representative for more information.
- 3) All items will be bid on via a sealed bid process by the time of closing. **The bid closing time will be listed on each item**; make sure you check each item for the closing date as they can all be different. All bids must be emailed to the email address at the top of that listing page. If you do not have email capabilities, contact the representative at the top of the page and a bid will be submitted on your behalf. An “Equipment Waiver for Remote Bidding” form must then be completed. All bids must: have the full dollar amount, include your name/address/email/telephone number. **If you are a new customer to BC Livestock you will be required to fill out the new buyer form.**
- 4) All items will be subject to GST & PST unless you submit a Farm Folio number for those items that are PST exempt. If you are the winning bidder, GST & PST will be added to your bid (unless Farm Folio supplied for PST exemption).
- 5) Any bids received after the closing time will not be accepted! The winning bidder will be contacted immediately upon close of the auction, subject to owner’s accepting the final bid. If you have not been contacted, you were not the top bid. We will not be disclosing winning bids.
- 6) If there are two or more winning bids for the same amount, there will be a bid-off.
- 7) Items must be paid for in full before being released to the purchaser.
- 8) Payment options:
  - a) VISA/MASTERCARD - \$5,000 limit
  - b) **New!** As of May 5<sup>th</sup> you will be able to pay as a bill payment via BMO online banking only, by searching: **BC LIVESTOCK PRODUCERS COOP ASSOCIATION**. You will need to contact us for your personal account number. Website will be updated as other banks come online.
  - c) Cheque
- 9) Items must be picked up within **10 days of purchase**, and you must make arrangements with the representative to pick up your items. **Do not contact the seller directly.**
