The fall run is in full swing with sale receipts growing weekly. High volume coupled with the high cost of feed continues to keep pressure on the calf market. The outlook is strong, it just costs much more than the average year for feed, which is affecting your prices. Slaughter cows and bulls are weaker because there is a pile of finished cattle coming onto the market right now. Once again, it is cow and bull season, so when you market a plethora of one commodity at the same time, coupled with all the other mitigating factors, it will pressure the market down. However, in most cases, ranchers are short on feed so it doesn't make sense to feed open cows or used up bulls until the price strengthens, because the gains in price per pound are going to be offset by the feed you have to put through them. 
