Current Market Report

Finished cattle are smoking hot in the United States with most fats in the South trading at 1.40 USD. That is consequently driving the feeder price through the roof in the USA, which will inevitably push our market higher in the New Year, both on finished cattle, and feeder cattle. Talk of a strike at the Cargill plant in High River has some markets a little uneasy; if they do strike or get locked out (which was the latest news on the wire as of vesterday), it would put extreme pressure on finished cattle and the cull cow trade, so let's hope they come to a resolution and we don't go there. Calf prices continue to be steady: when figuring in the cost of delivery to Feedlot Central, the BC calf market is extremely strong. Steer calves continue to be well sought after while the heifer calves continue to lag behind because of their poor performance in the feedlot compared to a steer. Moving to the cattle futures, there has been choppy trade the last few sessions! It's hard to tell which direction they will go next, but that being said, even with the high cost of feed and production right now, the feeder cattle make sense when looking at the futures. Currently it's only the lack of pen space and capacity holding back higher prices. We continue to have all agricultural producers in our thoughts and prayers who are dealing with these atmospheric rivers that are bringing more flooding to B.C. The one thing I know is that Ag producers are strong, and also dedicated to producing a safe, sustainable food supply for our population, so they will pick themselves up by the boot straps and continue on, although currently being devastated. It's absolutely heartbreaking to see what many communities and producers are faced with at this time. We are here to help in any way we can. Cordy Cox GM BCL
